



Canadian spotlight 19.1: Key additions from the first half of July 2022

In the first half of July, contributing Canadian evidence-synthesis teams have shared with us four newly completed evidence syntheses which are listed in the table below. One of the syntheses provides insight across two domains of the COVID-END taxonomy (public-health measures and clinical management). The remaining focused on public-health measures (n=2) and health-system arrangements (n=1).
