



## Canadian spotlight 7.2: Key additions from the second half of July 2021

In the second half of July, contributing Canadian evidence-synthesis teams have shared with us 11 newly completed evidence syntheses which are listed in the table below. Two of these syntheses provide insight across all domains of the COVID-END taxonomy (public-health measures, clinical management, health-system arrangements, and economic and social responses) and the remaining focus on public-health measures (n=3), and clinical management (n=6).
