Never needed evidence contextualization more (what does the research evidence mean for us in our context given the state of the pandemic and pandemic responses and local values and preferences)</p> <p>f. Never needed effective communication of high-quality and locally contextualized findings more (in hours not months, in plain language and in multiple languages, and in ways that combat mis-information)</p> <p>g.
