Motivation

- Explosion in COVID-19 Knowledge that also has led to an explosion in hubs containing this knowledge.
- One estimate shows more 23,000 papers COVID-19 literature published since January more than and is doubling every 20 days—among the biggest explosions of scientific literature ever (Brainard, 2020).
- Numerous entities producing and / or collecting this knowledge, albeit with duplications (e.g. government policy trackers).



• Challenges in **finding the best-fit** COVID-19 knowledge to one's context in the **shortest period** of time possible.

Objective

- The Living Hub of COVID-19 Knowledge Hubs aims to systematically collate all hubs of COVID-19-related knowledge into one platform, a one-stop-shop or hub of hubs.
- Allow users such as health and social systems decision-makers to rapidly identify the most relevant resources.
- Covid-19 Knowledge Hubs are broadly defined as any publicly available platforms whose main area of focus is to gather and share relevant research, data, and other types of evidence related to the Covid-19 pandemic.









Eligibility criteria

The Living Hub of COVID-19 Knowledge Hubs includes HUBS with:

- Resources that have a clear scope to be used by decision-makers in the public sector.
- A dedicated section or an easy-to-access filter to select the specific COVID-19 resources.
- At least one of i) documents that collate evidence ii) epidemiology information iii) description of government responses
- At **least two** of i) expert opinions ii) other resources related to research activities e.g., funding opportunities.
- No limitation on regional scope of hub, outcomes and sector.







Data extraction

The process:

- Project from Mid-April to end of June.
- Total 4 coders involved.
- All coding in Google sheets.
- Reconciliation of coding questions in weekly meetings.
- 213 hubs data extracted.

The information extracted:

- Identification of the Hub (description, geographical scope)
- Eligibility criteria (2 categories)
- Characteristics of the Hub (as organization)
- Type of resources available
- Characteristics of the resources available
- Information topics
- Characteristics of the website (including response mechanism for policymakers)











Updating the Living Hub of COVID-19 Knowledge Hubs

- Committed to weekly updates for the next month.
- Next phase focuses on **snowballing** currently included hubs with external links.
- Then, run the **searches each week** and code newly included hubs.
- For next month: open for inputs from COVID-END partners, but not external stakeholders.
- Eventually, also need to check hubs that have been already coded for any characteristics that might have changed. Different to living SRs as some included hubs are 'living' themselves.
