 Evidence synthesis activities are of variable quality

New entrants not always aware of best approaches and tools

More duplication of synthesis than is constructive

Evidence ecosystem less coordinated than optimal

High-quality, synthesized evidence to meet needs of decision makers not always available in a timely way
