



Key Pressures on Healthcare Providers in Canada ²⁰²⁵

Workforce Shortages & Burnout

Projected shortage of doctors and nurses, high levels of burnout

Primary Care Access Crisis

Over 20% of Canadians lack a family doctor or nurse practitioner

Mental Health Crisis

Mental health demand three times higher than pre-pandemic levels

Financial Strain & Infrastructure Challenges

Hospitals facing structural deficits and aging infrastructure

Climate Change & Health System Resilience

Environmental impacts straining healthcare systems


Integration of Internationally Trained Professionals
