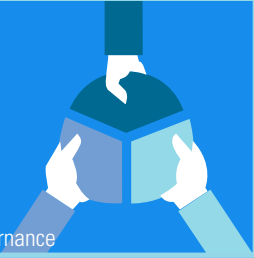
Collaborative governance is a governing arrangement in which leaders from organizations drawn from multiple sectors **engage in a collective decision-making process that is deliberative, consensus-oriented, and directed to the achievement of a shared goal**

Key considerations for success:

-  1. Establish trust among partners
-  2. Choices about end state aren't needed right now

Collaborative decision-making agreements (CDMA)

-  Allow us to understand each others' commitments, and hold each other accountable
-  Need to be self-determined and fit for purpose

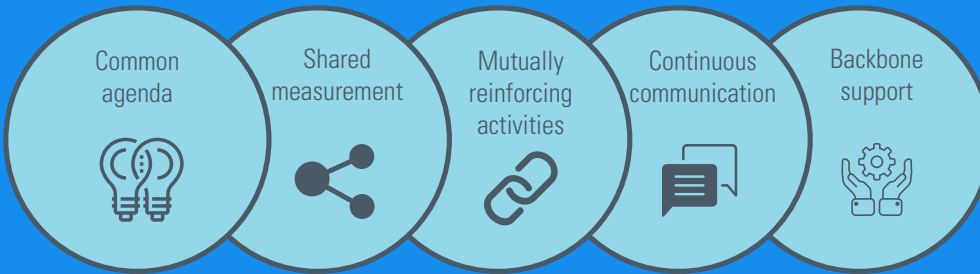
